



Beaumont Adult School Certified Nursing Assistant Program

Program description:

Beaumont Adult School CNA program is approved by the California State Health Board to prepare each student for employment and the state certification exam. Certified Nursing Assistants work in various settings such as long term care centers, rehabilitation facilities, assisted living centers, and Board & Care homes to provide direct care to residents and assist nurses. The course consists of classroom instruction and hands on application in the clinical setting for a total of 240 hours.

Prerequisites:

Proof of High School Diploma (official/sealed transcript required) or proof of Equivalency
Successful completion of a reading exam at a minimum of 240 scaled score (9th grade reading level)
Original California Driver's License or government issued photo ID (photocopy will be made in the office)
Original Social Security card or right to work document (photocopy will be made in the office)
No felony convictions

Program requirements:

Proof of Negative TB test (within the last 9 months) or negative chest x-ray (within the last year)
Proof of Hepatitis B vaccine or vaccination declination form
Physical examination (stating no physical lifting restrictions)
Proof of flu vaccine (during applicable season- Fall/Winter)

American Heart Association CPR card- BLS (Basic Life Support)

Program Completion Requirements:

- Maintain a minimum of 75% grade average and a 95% attendance rate
- Perform all skills and job functions to satisfactory performance to successfully work as a Certified Nursing Assistant
- Pass criminal background check through Department of Justice (Livescan fingerprints will be completed during the program)
- Personal transportation to and from clinical sites and BAS campus (we do not provide support for transportation)
- Full attendance, including make-up of hours due to absence, to ensure all state mandated clinical hours (minimum 100 hrs) and state approved theory/laboratory hours (88 hours) have been met

Application Process: (must be provide to office in person)

1. Complete CNA application and turn in to office with:
 - Official/sealed High School Transcripts or High School Equivalency documentation
 - Original driver's license or government issued photo ID
 - Original social security card or government issued right to work document
2. Take a reading comprehension exam (CASAS). Results are given immediately upon completion.
3. Upon successful completion of exam the applicant will be placed in the lottery
4. Following lottery pick applicant will be notified via email of acceptance/denial into the Beaumont Adult School CNA Program.
