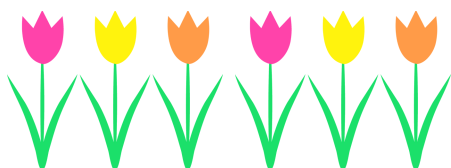


## Registration Information

Registration for the 2018-2019 school year for current students will be opening very soon. Please note the following:

- All enrollment is done online through our district website [www.lex2.org](http://www.lex2.org)
- You will be required to login using your email and a password. The office does not have access to your passwords, so you may need to reset it to continue with the process.
- Bring to the office: Two current proofs of residence (one utility bill and a lease/mortgage.)
- The school nurse may make contact with families that need to turn in updated immunization forms.
- Ipads are available in the office for enrollment use from 9-1 during the week.
- Students will not be placed in classes next year until necessary paperwork and online enrollment is completed.

Phrases such as "I can do it" and "I'll never give up" should be heard often in your home. If someone in your family exhibits perseverance take notice and let them know you're proud. Tell them, "I know this was difficult, but you stuck with it and accomplished your goal". Praise will help motivate each other and let each other know that you noticed their hard work. If a member of your family has a task that seems incredibly unmanageable.
