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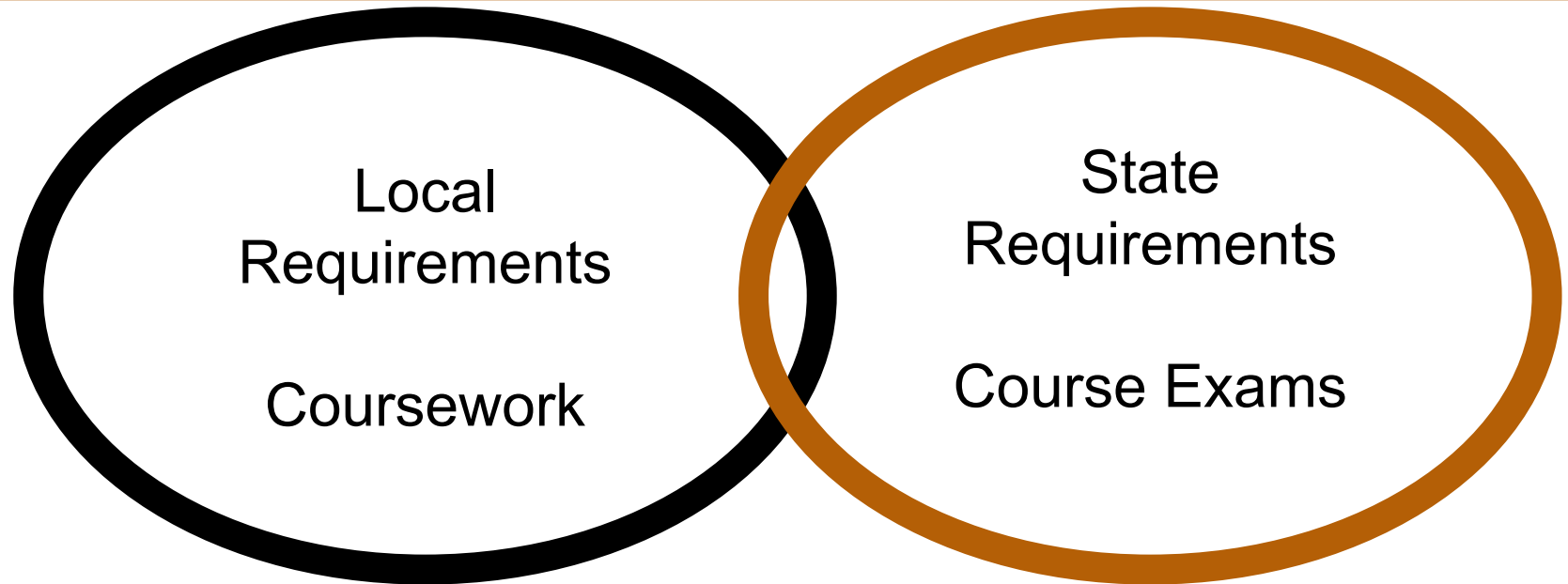

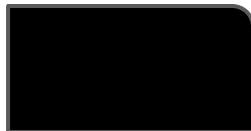

- Algebra I taken as 8th grader - score of 3 automatically



# Exam Retakes

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Students scoring a 1 or 2 (below proficient)

- Additional instruction
- Multiple retake times will be available

Students scoring a 3 or 4 (proficient/accelerated)

- Only after all tests have been attempted
  - Only if graduation points are not met
