




## Crean Lutheran strikes early, rolls over Bolsa Grande

IRVINE - Crean Lutheran rode a hot start to a 57-0 victory over Bolsa Grande in a nonleague game Friday at Irvine High School.

The Saints scored on their first three possessions of the game, taking a quick 21-0 lead behind two rushing touchdowns from senior running back **Zach Macadam**.

Crean Lutheran (4-1) finished with 329 yards rushing yards.

For Bolsa Grande (1-4), quarterback **Andrew Guillen** could not manage much offense through the first half. The Matadors' longest play in the half was 7 yards.

As crisp as the offense looked for Crean Lutheran, the defensive line for the Saints also came to play on homecoming night. The trio of **Tanner Atkinson**, **Christian Maurier** and **Maximus Bahou** continually were in the Matadors backfield. Senior **David Strahan** managed 3 yards on eight carries.

As the first half went on, Crean Lutheran running back **Jack Johnson** guided the offense into the red zone with chunk runs. Johnson gained 105 yard on 15 carries in the first half.

At the 5:49 mark, quarterback **Gavin Folsom** called his own number from 7 yards out to make the score 28-0.

With 1:36 left in the second quarter, cornerback **Issac Holbrook** intercepted a pass at the Bolsa Grande 20 and ran it back for a touchdown.

The Saints added a field goal with two seconds left in the quarter to take a 44-0 lead into halftime.

The pounding run attack continued from Crean Lutheran in the second half. Macadam ran for a 48-yard touchdown on the second play of scrimmage in third quarter, and fellow back **Anthony Cooper** turned the right corner in route to a 55-yard touchdown at the 8:52 mark in the fourth quarter.

Bolsa Grande defensive tackle **Juan Matias** was a bright spot for the Matadors in the second half, stuffing multiple run plays in the backfield.
