



I. English | 4 Credits

Every student will be enrolled in an English class *every semester* until 4 English credits are earned, *including* English Composition I (ENG 121).

II. Math | 4 Credits

Every student will be enrolled in a math class *every semester* until 4 math credits are earned, *including* Geometry (1 credit), MAT 090 (1 credit), MAT 099 (1 credit), and College Algebra (MAT 121).

III. Science | 3 Credits

Every student must earn 3 science credits, *including* Biology A (0.5 credits), Biology B (0.5 credits), Chemistry (0.5 credits), and Physics (0.5 credits).

IV. Social Science | 3 Credits

Every student must earn 3 social science credits, *including* U.S. History I (0.5 credits), U.S. History II (0.5 credits), U.S. Government (0.5 credits), and World History* (0.5 credits).

V. World Languages | 2 Credits

Every student must earn 2 credits of the same world language.

VI. College and Career Readiness | 0.5 Credits

Every student must earn 0.5 credits of College and Career Readiness.

VII. Academic Electives | 3.5 Credits

Students may take electives upon successful completion of high school requirements I-VI.
