# P-20 YEAR 2 PRIORITY 1

## PRIORITY 1

SBCISD will implement a developmentally appropriate and aligned curriculum for Prekindergarten and Kindergarten students with quality instruction supported through targeted professional development, which ensures students are postsecondary ready.

### P20.1.2.0 Year 2 Goal: Sustain a full day Pre-Kindergarten Program.

**Monitor, enhance and adjust the adopted PK curriculum as needed.**

## STATUS [April 2018]

- All twelve elementary schools at SBCISD offer full day Prekindergarten for the 2017-2018 school year for all age appropriate students.
- Pre-K Thematic units are utilized to deliver instruction through The Opening the World of Learning [OWL] curriculum district wide. The curriculum targets the 10 domains: social/emotional, language, alliteration: writing and reading, emergent literacy, mathematics, social studies, science, fine arts, physical development, and technology.

# P-20 YEAR 2 PRIORITY 1

## **STATUS [April 2018] Continued:**

- The BOY and MOY CIRCLE Assessments has been administered to all Pre-kindergarten students.
- January 25, 2018 - All Prekindergarten teachers received 9 kindles for student use at school or home.
- February 2, 2018 – Prekindergarten teachers received notification regarding online professional development through CLI Engage.
- The first round for pre-registration for full day Prekindergarten for the 2018-2019 school year occurred April 2-6, 2018 and Saturday April 7<sup>th</sup> at the John F. Barron Boardroom.

## **NEXT STEPS:**

- EOY progress monitoring April 16<sup>th</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup> 2018.
- Additional registration opportunities are slated for Saturday April 28<sup>th</sup> at San Benito High School, and on the week of April 30<sup>th</sup> through May 4<sup>th</sup> home at all elementary campuses.

# P-20 YEAR 2 PRIORITY 2

## PRIORITY 2

SBCISD will create a community network with local governments, institutions of higher education, and community organizations to eliminate barriers for post secondary success.

**Formalize a community network to eliminate barriers for post secondary success for all students.**

## STATUS [APRIL 2018]

- Reviewed Clearinghouse data with administrative team.
- Reviewed TSI, ACT/SAT, and PSAT data for student in grades 8<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup>.
- January 8, 2018 - Met with TAMUK regarding dual enrollment course offerings for Spring 2018, Summer 2018, and Fall 2018.
- March 8, 2018 - Met with parents and students regarding the Early College Academy.

# P-20 YEAR 2 PRIORITY 2

## **STATUS [APRIL 2018] Continued:**

- March 2, 2018 - Met with VMA and high school administration and counselors to discuss schedule for students attending Early College Academy in 2018-2019.
- April 5, 2018 – contacted P-20 committee members via email regarding committee meeting on April 26th to discuss postsecondary readiness data.
- April 5, 2018 – submitted dual enrollment packets to TAMAUK.

## **NEXT STEPS:**

- April 26, 2018 – Meet with P-20 Committee at San Benito High School.
- Continue to evaluate and disaggregate TSI, ACT/SAT, and PSAT data for student in grades 8<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup>.
- Test 8<sup>th</sup> grade students with TSI the week of May 21<sup>st</sup> through 25<sup>th</sup>.
- Schedule dual enrollment courses for spring 2019 and Summer 2019.

# P-20 YEAR 2 PRIORITY 3

## **PRIORITY 3**

SBCISD will create a district culture that promotes and emphasizes the importance of academic preparedness and supports the belief that a post secondary education is critical and attainable for all students.

**P20.3.2 Year 2 Goal: SBCISD conduct research on P-12 curriculum for post secondary readiness .**

**Research P-12 curriculum focused on post secondary readiness activities and purchase district-wide.**

## **STATUS [April 2018]**

- August 23, 2017 – Reviewed Naviance PK- 5<sup>th</sup> platform and lessons.
- April 5, 2018 – Reviewed post secondary readiness results via district Comprehensive Needs Assessment.
- April 6, 2018 – Research AVID and Achieve.
- April 9, 2018 - Evaluated data from Naviance through usage reports and principal input.

# P-20 YEAR 2 PRIORITY 3

## NEXT STEPS:

- Teacher survey regarding Naviance Implementation and usage.
- Continue to research post secondary programs for k-12.
- Schedule meetings with AVID, Naviance, and Achieve consultants.



# P-20 YEAR 2 PRIORITY 4

## PRIORITY 4

SBCISD will support college and career opportunities in academic offerings in order to provide the academic knowledge and preparation students will need for success in college and careers.

P20.4.2 Year 2 Goal: SBCISD will create vertical alignment teams to support increased academic rigor and ensure faculty awareness of academic expectations for college readiness.

SBCISD will create vertical alignment teams in the four content areas in order to create a scope and sequence in support of academic standards for college readiness that is vertically aligned and easily accessible and usable.

## STATUS [April 2018]

- February 16, 2018 - TEKS Resources System Professional Development for administrators.
- TEKS Resource system Professional development for teachers at Region I.
- TEKS Resource System is utilized by K-12 teachers.

# P-20 YEAR 2 PRIORITY 4

## **STATUS [APRIL 2018] Continued:**

- CCMRS annotated on PK through 12<sup>th</sup> grade lessons plans.
- All campuses hold Professional Learning Community sessions to ensure vertical alignment within core subject areas.

## **NEXT STEPS:**

- Ensure all campuses hold cross curricular vertical alignment meetings once a month.

# P-20 YEAR 2 PRIORITY 5

## PRIORITY 5

SBCISD will ensure early and continuous exposure to college and careers for all of its students.

**P20.5.2 – Year 1 Goal: College and career outreach will be made available to all students and parents.**

**College and career outreach to students and parents will be made available on all SBCISD campuses.**

## **STATUS [April 2018]**

- Elementary, middle, and high schools held career and college fairs.
- Fifth grade students researched colleges and focused on entrance requirements and financial obligations.
- FASFA Application nights held at San Benito High School and Gateway Academy.

# P-20 YEAR 2 PRIORITY 5

## **STATUS [APRIL 2018] Continued:**

- Dual enrollment course offerings at San Benito high School and Veterans Memorial Academy during the school day, and afterschool.
- March 29, 2018 – Met with high school counselors regrading information on video. Created outline.
- April 2, 2016 – Met with high school counselors to discuss how to present dual enrollment and Advanced Placement opportunities to rising Freshman.
- Utilized Naviance college readiness lessons and interest tests in grades 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup>.

## **NEXT STEPS**

- Middle school students will visit college campuses in May. [TSTC & UTRGV]
- Post video in district website for rising Freshman and parents, which contains information on grade point average, class ranking, dual enrollment opportunities, and endorsements.
- Create schedule for college and career fairs.
- Create schedule for college nights, which includes FASFA information and college recruiters/presenters.
