In an effort to keep your child safe and our school free from dangerous contraband, Ouchi-O'Donovan 6-12 Complex may conduct random canine searches throughout the school year. The goal of the canine searches is to alert school staff to the presence of substances and/or dangerous items that are prohibited by law.

The canines may sniff the air around lockers, desks and classrooms on school property or at school-sponsored events. Canines will not sniff within the close proximity of students without reasonable suspicion. Students will be allowed to remove their personal belongings from classrooms prior to canines entering.
