## CENTER PROGRAMS!

**Story & Craft Hour:** *The purpose of Storytime is not to teach the child how to read, but rather to encourage the love of language and literature in all its forms. Kids listen to, observe and imitate the books and activities we share, thus building reading readiness as they grow. Our goal is to create positive interactions with books for the parent and the child to experience together.*

**Ready! Set! School! ## PARENT WORKSHOPS!

**10 Ways to Help Your Child Succeed in School:** *This workshop gives Parents 10 practical ways to help their child be successful in school. Sharing 5 ways you are able to prepare your child at home for learning and 5 ways to support your child, teacher, and all school staff in being successful in your child's learning process.*

**Building Blocks to Literacy:** *This workshop will increase a parent's skill and confidence in helping their children practice and review the reading skills taught to the children at their age level by their teacher.
