- ◆ Be a dues paying student member of the Valencia High School PTSA. Upon acceptance into the PTSA Student Leadership, student member dues must be received by September 30, 2016.
- ◆ Will be responsible for attending meetings, PTSA sponsored activities, and pertinent committee meetings.
- ◆ May chair an event/project.
- ◆ May attend a leadership workshop, conference, or convention.
- ◆ PTSA Student Leadership Group members will receive a Student Leadership shirt to be worn at all activities.
- ◆ Must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA and good citizenship record in school and in the community.
- ◆ Be a positive role model and sincerely interested in making a positive difference by embracing the purpose of PTSA.
- ◆ Involvement may incur personal expense.
- ◆ It is the responsibility of each member to be apprised of all current PTSA business. If a meeting is missed, please contact someone for the information. Reminder calls/emails are a courtesy.
- ◆ Students must notify the advisor if they are unable to attend a meeting or service activity.
- ◆ Our student-based group is service-oriented and actively involved. We strive to be people of good character and develop positive leadership qualities. We encourage each member to be a vital part of our meetings and activities.
