

WHAT A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER'S TREATMENT ORDER MUST INCLUDE

- STUDENT (name, birth date)
- Name of Procedure
- Reason or Indication
- What staff can perform
- Trained lay staff _____ RN only _____ LVN _____
- Designated trainer of lay staff
- When performed (schedule or indicators)
- How to perform (e.g., copy of instructions to parents)
- Precautions and what to do
- Date within current school year
- Legible name of health care provider/address/phone number
- Signature of health care provider
- Parent's signed request for school to accept order

State Law and Local Policy determine whether non-licensed persons can do some or all procedures.

WHAT A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER'S ORDER MUST INCLUDE

- The student's name, date of birth, and gender
- Date within current school year
- The name of the medication
- The medication dosage
- The time the medication is to be given at school
- Duration that the medication is to be given at school
- The route by which the medication will be taken
- Special instructions
- Healthcare provider's legible name/address/phone number
- Healthcare provider's signature

For the purpose of orders, a healthcare provider must be a physician licensed to practice in the State of Texas.
