

Tooele High School Options for Recognition at Graduation



Graduating seniors can receive recognition in many areas:

Honors Diploma: Students must apply for the Honors program prior to mid-term of first term in their sophomore year. They must complete all requirements outlined in the THS brochure. Those who qualify will have 'Honors Diploma' stamped on their transcript, a diploma bearing an Honors Seal and will wear a silver gown at graduation ceremonies.

White Buffalo Award: Students graduating with a cumulative GPA of 3.700 or higher will receive a Gold Cord and a White Buffalo pin to wear at graduation.

Silver Cord: Students graduating with a cumulative GPA of 3.500 to 3.699 will receive a Silver Cord to wear at graduation.

Sterling Scholars: Seniors selected to represent THS as a Sterling Scholar in their selected area will be recognized on the graduation program.

National Honor Society: Members of the National Honor Society, who have completed all the necessary requirements, will be recognized with a NHS collar to wear at graduation.

Enrichment Cords: Enrichments are awarded in attendance, activities, and coursework categories. A brochure (counseling office) outlines all requirements for these various cords and the application process.

Utah Scholars: Students who apply for Utah Scholars status and complete the course and GPA requirements, will earn a certificate and a medallion.

CTE Medallion: Students who complete a CTE pathway will receive a medallion to wear at graduation. See CTE Pathway booklet for more information.
