

Collierville High School Graduation Information

Graduation Tickets (Available May 1st)

Each senior is allotted ten tickets for family and friends. Graduates do not need a ticket. Parents/Seniors may pick up the tickets in the Collierville High School Main Office. There is no charge for graduation tickets. **One ticket per person is required for admission to the ceremony.**

Scholarship Recognition (April 20th)

All seniors receiving award letters should bring a copy to Mrs. Taylor in the Counseling Office by Friday, April 20th. This is the priority date for graduation program deadline. Letters received after this date will go in the Class of 2018 final tally.

Final Transcript Request (April 23rd-27th)

The name of the school to receive a copy of the final transcript is due by Friday, April 27th. A list will be distributed in the senior English classes during the last week of April. There is no charge for this transcript. Final transcripts will be mailed the last week of May.

MANDATORY ATTENDANCE!

Seniors only!

Seniors not present for the practice WILL NOT participate in the commencement exercise. Seniors will enter the Fellowship Building on the west side – Appling Street entrance. **Students are to be seated by 10:30am in the Fellowship Hall.** Each chair will have the name of a 2018 graduate (in alphabetical order). Sit where you find your name. *Regular school dress code will be enforced for graduation practice.

GRADUATION

Seniors must arrive by 6:00pm SHARP!

Dress: No flip flops, tennis shoes, or jeans!

Ladies: Dress, skirt or dress slacks and blouse. Low heeled dress shoes are strongly suggested. No purses.

Gentlemen: Dress shirt with a tie, dress slacks (no denim) and dress shoes.

Cap and gown must be brought on a hanger. Bobby pins may be needed to secure cap in place for girls and boys. Cap is to be worn flat on top of the head with the tassel to the right. No cell phones, noisemakers, silly string, or other paraphernalia are to be brought to graduation. Any student financially unable to meet the dress code should see their counselor before Friday, May 11th.

Seating – Seniors must be in their seats in the Fellowship Hall no later than 6:00pm attired in their cap and gown. Each senior will be subject to search before the ceremony begins. Seniors will not be permitted to leave the Fellowship Hall with their cap and gown on any time after 6:00pm.

Diplomas

Seniors will keep their gowns. All graduates need to check in with their homeroom teacher immediately after the graduation ceremony in the Fellowship Hall. Homeroom teachers will issue seniors their diplomas, class composite, and other school/health records at that time.

Graduation Guests

Each guest will be required to have a ticket to enter the doors to the church. All bags/purses will be searched upon entry. All flowers, balloons, gifts, etc. **MUST** be left in the car. They will not be allowed inside of the church.
