**GENERAL MEETING**

Meeting was called to order at 3:23 pm.

**WELCOME:**

Dr. Narro welcomed the parents and staff for coming to the School Site Council meeting.

**BUSINESS**

1. Review and approve September 14, 2016 minutes
  - a. Correction was made on SPSA Development
  - b. Gina Loyonnet made a motion to approve the minutes.
  - c. Laurie Narro seconded the motion.
  - d. Motion passed
  
2. SPSA Development
  - a. Dr. Narro shared SPSA goals. The SPSA goals get presented to the school board.
  - b. SSC members discussed goal #1. For math, the goal for this upcoming school year is an increase of proficient students by 2% overall as measured by CAASPP. Also, an increase of proficient Hispanic students by 4%.
  - c. Goal #2 was discussed. For English Language Arts, the goal for this upcoming school year is an increase of proficient students by 2% overall as measured by CAASPP. Also, an increase of proficient Hispanic students by 4%.
  - d. Teachers at the beginning of the school year review CAASPP data. The data is broken into skills.
  - e. During grade level meetings, teachers created a list of strategies of what they are going to do to meet goal #1 and #2
  - f. Goal #3 was discussed. Teachers will be able to attend CGI training. Math and language arts are being supported through professional development days. Teachers will conduct the professional developments. There is a focus on rolling out a technology scope and sequence plan. English Language Arts curriculum piloting meetings are being provided for those teachers that are piloting ELA. It has been 16 years since an ELA adoption. All teachers are attending PLTW (STEM) training that are aligned with the NGSS.
  - g. Goal #4 was discussed. CHKS results were reviewed in a staff meeting. Goal #4 encompasses the big idea. Second Step program incorporates a common language among students and staff. Second Step is a program focuses on the

social emotional growth of students. Some teachers also or instead use another social emotional curriculum. Some programs focus on building a community and inclusion. A goal is for the school counselor to be involved in the social emotional Student Success Team meetings, to meet with students and to provide support to students in the classroom. The school counselor will also try to be available to deliver Second Step lessons. Teachers created a list of ideas to help support goal #4.

- h. We will be pulling data for English Language Arts and Mathematics. Also enter classrooms to see if Professional Developments has helped. We will like to sample some students for goal #4.
  - i. Grace Kung asked if the data is similar with all the schools. Dr. Narro stated that the areas that need improvement are the same but the data was slightly different.
  - j. Robyn Saito moved to approve the SPSA.
  - k. Elda Marquez seconded the motion.
  - l. Motion passed
