### Parent Information:

One parent per student is welcome to attend this amazing trip! It's a TVCS favorite of both students and parents! The cost for a parent is \$65. In addition, all parent participants must have a Live Scan FBI and DOJ report on file with TVCS Administration. This form is attached and results must be received no later than March 8<sup>th</sup>! We recommend you do your Live Scan immediately, if you haven't already. In most cases it takes a few days for the results to arrive but occasionally it has taken weeks for some families. If you've already had one for TVCS as a field trip driver, chaperone, school coach or employee, you won't need to do another one. They are good for the whole time you are at TVCS. You may choose the location for your Live Scan, just be sure to use the form we've provided. The Live Scan is at parent expense. Many of our families use the Police Station at the Promenade Mall in Temecula. The cost there is approximately \$59. While on the trip, parents will be in charge of assisting groups and helping the Indian Hills staff with the activities. Sleeping accommodations are in wagons/cabins. It really is an unforgettable experience for our students!
