Policy Reminders

- Car Riders Procedure 1: Cars should get in the line that forms on the blacktop highway facing the rear of the school or bus loading area. They remain in the line until all buses have been unloaded/loaded. Then they proceed to the staircase area, stop, and let the student(s) out the car. Then they continue through the circle without parking for any reason. If you need to park to bring in supplies, etc. you must park in the front parking lot and use the front staircase. Pick up procedures will be the same in the afternoon.
- Car Riders Procedure 2: Car riders may park in the front school circle, get out, and walk the student(s) through the second set of doors into the foyer. They may release them there prior to 8:15 A.M. At the end of the day they may park and come through the foyer to the rear set of steps to pick up student(s).
- Anyone not following the above procedures are considered to have a student in a restricted area and the consequences for that rule will apply.
- Students are not allowed on campus before 7:50 AM. The first bell rings at 8:10 AM. The school day begins at 8:15 AM. Students arriving after 8:15 AM time are considered tardy and a parent or approved adult must sign them in to school in the front office. Students not signed in correctly are placed in ISS until an adult comes to sign them in.
- No bus passes will be issued over the phone.
- Designs and/or lines may not be cut into eyebrows or hair.
- Uniform pants are to have the traditional khaki pant leg. (No cargo pants will be allowed)
- A BELT must be worn at the waist with all uniform bottoms. Belts should be school colors (Carolina blue, navy blue, grey), white, khaki, or black.
- Only school approved jackets can be worn inside the building. All other jackets must be taken off when entering the building.
- Undershirts, if worn, must be solid school colors, white or black.
- Shirts must be tucked in at all time.
- Socks must be worn. Sock must be school colors, black, or white. Both socks must also be the same.
- No electronic devices are allowed at school.
