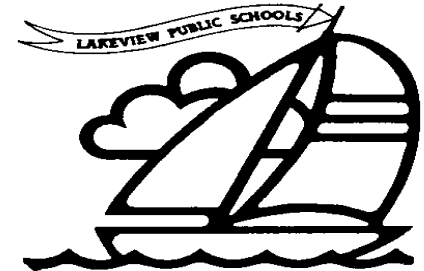

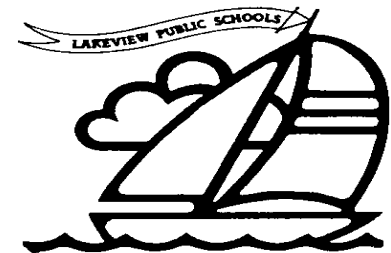

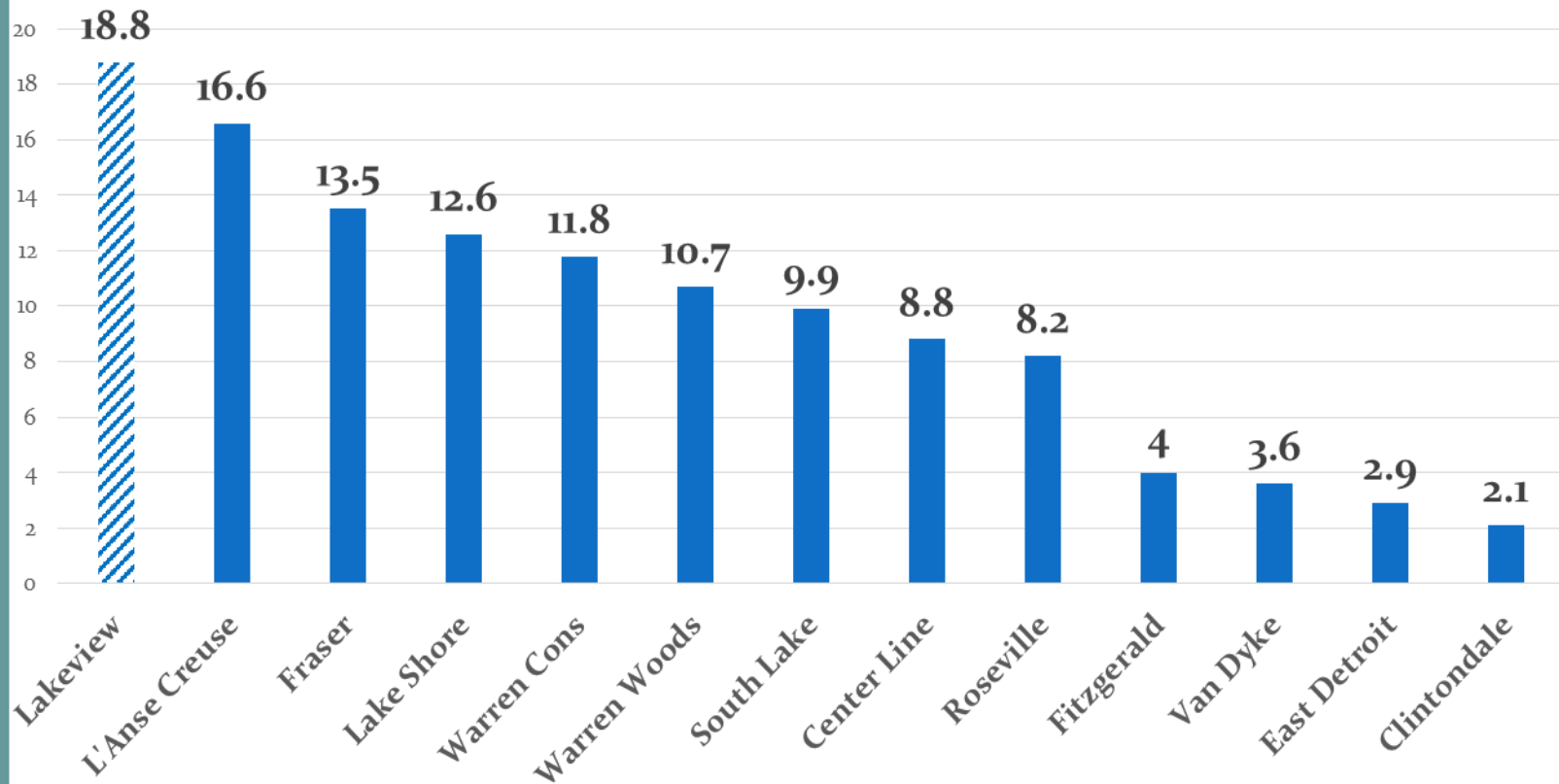


Third Grade – MSTEP 2016-17

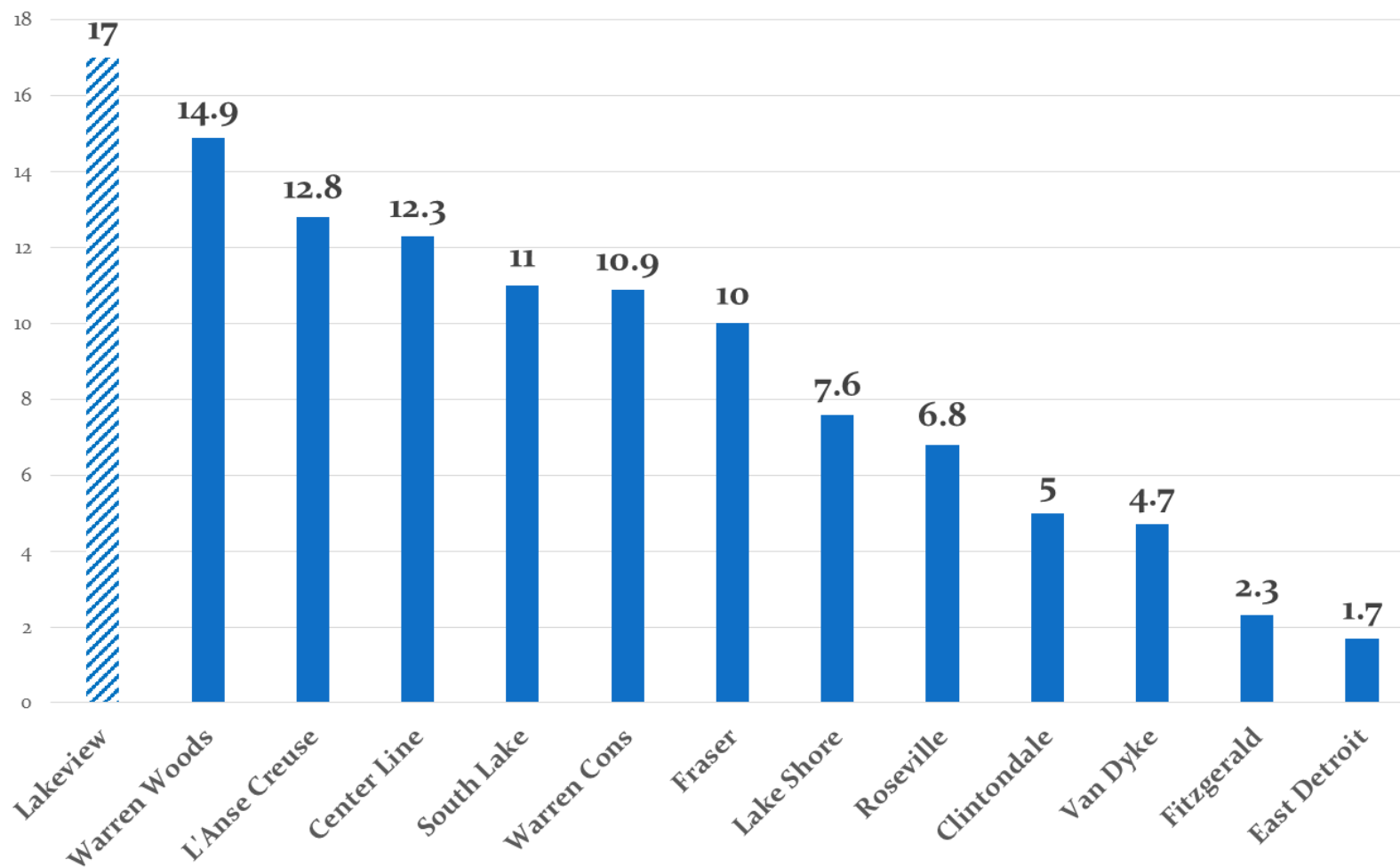
