DRUG/ALCOHOL TESTING - COVERED DRIVERS</p> <p>The Board recognizes that the use and abuse of drugs and alcohol is a serious problem that may be present in the workplace. The Board also recognizes that an employee impaired by drugs or alcohol who operates district vehicles or transports students poses significant risks to the safety of students and others.</p> <p>A covered driver shall mean any district employee who drives, operates or is in the actual physical control or movement of a school bus, school vehicle, or a commercial vehicle owned, leased or operated by the school district. The term includes drivers and mechanics who operate such vehicles, including full-time, regularly employed individuals; casual, intermittent or occasional individuals; and leased drivers; and independent owner-operator contractors who are either directly employed by or under lease to the district or who operate a bus owned or leased by the district.</p> <p>The Board establishes that transportation companies contracted by the Board shall provide a program of drug and alcohol testing for covered drivers. A statement ensuring such program shall be included in the contracted agreement.</p> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
