Welcome & Introductions	Dr. Patton welcomed everyone. Sign-In Sheet was circulated for signatures. Members not in attendance were Lizette Amaro , Christina Sandoval and Donna Hale.
January 20th, 2016 Minutes Review & Approval	Approved minutes from January 20 th , 2016 meeting. Motion was made to approve the minutes as is by Ms. Tombrello, Seconded by Ms. Velarde Aye: 7; Noes 0 Minutes Passed.
October, 2015 CELDT Results	<p>Dr. Patton shared the annual results from the California English Language Development Test (CELDT) that Mrs. Hale administers annually to all our English Language Learners.</p> <p>Students must receive an overall score of “Early Advanced” in order to qualify to be redesignated out of the program. They cannot get any sub-scores (Listening, Speaking, Reading, and Writing) below “Intermediate”. They also must be on level in their reading class and getting a ‘Basic” or higher on the SRI tests.</p> <p>Results:</p> <p>First Grade – 17 out of 18 received an overall score of “Early Advanced” on the CELDT. (we do not redesignate our 1st graders because we feel they are still learning and need an extra year to truly show mastery.</p> <p>Second Grade – 11 out of 12 receive an overall score of “Early Advanced” on the CELDT. They are in the process of redesignation at this time.</p> <p>Third Grade – We only have 2 students and both did not qualify on their CELDT</p> <p>Fourth Grade – We only have 1 student and they did not qualify on their CELDT</p> <p>Fifth Grade – 1 out of 1 received an overall score of “Early Advance” on the CELDT.</p> <p>Sixth Grade – We only have 2 student and both did not qualify on their CELDT</p> <p>Seventh Grade – No EL students.</p> <p>Eighth Grade – 1 out of 3 received an overall score of “Early Advanced” on the CELDT.</p> <p>Of those that did not qualify to be redesignated several were also special ed students who have other learning issues. Two of them have only been in the US for a year or 2 and are just learning English.</p>
Upcoming Honors	<p>Dr. Patton discussed the upcoming honors we were nominated for:</p> <p>Gold Ribbon – We have a validation visit coming out on March 22nd. They will be focusing on our collaborative model.</p>

	National Blue Ribbon – Exemplary Highest Performing School. We are in the top 5% out of all schools K-8 in the state of California. Very high honor. More info to come on this.

English Learners will continue to achieve high levels of proficiency on the CELDT.</p> <p>Results – Above State Average</p> <p>Add Smarter Balanced Results under “Data ...academic gains” section.</p> <p>Remove “Title III” reference</p> <p>Change “SDAIE” reference to “Guided Language Acquisition Development” – GLAD (This needs to be changed throughout the remainder of the document whenever it references SDAIE.</p> <p>Change “SDAIE/SIOP” to Tapple</p> <p>Pg. 41 – remove ‘summers school’ reference in second to last bullet in top section.</p> <p>Pg. 42 – Change “EL Coordinator” to “Administrator of Compliance”</p> <p>Under 3a section – remove “School Loop” and add website, Remind 101, social media.</p> <p>Pg. 43 – Remove Zampaletras Family Reading (K-3) reference.</p> <p>Pg. 44 – Remove “d” – pertains to Title III</p> <p>Pg. 45 – Remove Title III reference in section 5a</p> <p>Pg. 47 – Remove Title III reference</p> <p>Section 2c – add ‘when possible’</p> <p>Pg. 48 & 49 – remove reference to Zampaletras.</p> <p>Pg. 50 – 6a – Should read “Teacher Technology Integration Coordinator (TK-8)</p> <p>6c – should read “1 computer lab – 68 iPad’s; TK-2nd: 2-1 ratio iPads; 3rd-5th: 1-1 ratio; 6th-8th: Apple One to One Computer for every student.</p> <p>6g – remove “Newly adopted”</p> <p>Last paragraph – add “8th” so it reads 6th – 8th ; Remove last line that starts with “By 2016...”</p> <p>Pg. 51 – Remove Title III reference</p> <p>Pg. 53 – Change “SDAIE” reference and put in “GLAD”</p> <p>Pg. 55 – change “not” to “NO”</p> <p>Dr. Patton explained that the changes for the remainder of the document will be done and emailed to team for their review prior to our next meeting.
