



A Guide to Understanding Your Report Card

Refer To the Sample Report Card on Page 2

- ① **Credit:** *Credit value of the course.*
Full year courses – 1 Credit Semester Courses – 0.5 Credit
- ② **MP:** *Marking Period*
- ③ **Mark:** *Marking Period Grade*
The grade you received in the class for the Marking Period indicated. This grade does not include any weighting associated with advanced level classes (honors, AP, IB, college).
- ④ **School Exam:** *School-issued Exam Grades*
These include midterm and final exams. These grades will only appear next to a course grade in the 2nd and 4th Marking Periods
- ⑤ **Regent Mark:** *Regents Exam Grade*
The grade earned on the New York State Regents Exam. This will appear in the 4th quarter only for classes in which a Regents Exam is administered.
- ⑥ **YTD AVG:** *Year to Date Average*
The average for the individual course. This grade includes any weighting associated with advanced level classes (honors, AP, IB, college).
- ⑦ **Comments:**
Comments and explanation of your grade, class performance, ways to improve, etc. Comments will only appear for the current marking period grade.
- ⑧ **MP Weighted Avg:** *Marking Period Weighted Average*
The overall average of all classes at the end of each Marking Period. This includes any weighting associated with advanced level classes (honors, AP, IB, college). **This is the average used to determine Honor Roll eligibility.**
- ⑨ **YTD AVG:** *Year to Date Average*
The overall average of all classes for the Marking Period multiplied by the number of credits. This includes any weighting associated with advanced level classes (honors, AP, IB, college).
- ⑩ **Cumm. Average:** *Cumulative Average*
The overall average of all classes for all years. (i.e., a senior's cumulative average includes grades from freshman, sophomore, and junior years, and current grades from their senior year) This includes any weighting associated with advanced level classes (honors, AP, IP, college). Also known as your GPA.
