School Responsibilities

Shackelford Elementary will:

1. Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive, safe, and effective learning environment that enable all children to meet the state's student academic achievement standards.

3. Provide parents with frequent information on their child's progress with report cards and progress reports.
4. Provide parents reasonable access to staff by notifying parents of conference period times, telephone numbers, e-mail addresses, sending level newsletters, and communicating via Facebook, the Shackelford website and other communication programs.
5. Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class and classroom activities through the district Partners and Education program and the building Parent-Teacher Organization. Parents may observe classrooms upon request (24 hour notice must be given.)

Parent Responsibilities

1. Monitoring attendance.
2. Ensuring that homework is completed.
3. Participating in decisions relating to my child's education.
4. Begin an active participant, when possible, in the PTO.
5. Staying informed by reading all notices from school and/or the district and responding in a timely manner.
6. Serving, when possible, on district and/or school teams and committees or as a campus volunteer.

Student Responsibilities

1. Complete my homework as it is assigned and ask for help when I need it.
2. Engage in independent or parent involved reading for 20-30 minutes a day, outside of the school day.
