GUEST WIRELESS NETWORK ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY

The Bordentown Regional School District provides wireless guest access for Instructional staff and students. Wireless access will provide internet access on your personal device. The provisions of the Technology Acceptable Use Policy (#6142.10) signed by staff and students at the beginning of each year shall apply to the use of personal devices while in district.

User's Acknowledgements

By requesting a guest wireless network account you acknowledge the following:

- A. Use of the Bordentown Regional School District guest wireless network is solely at the risk of the user. The district disclaims any and all liability for loss of information, damage resulting from such loss, or any and all damages, including but not limited to financial obligations or losses resulting from the use of the guest wireless network;
- B. The Bordentown Regional School District Technology Department will not provide technical support of any kind on personal devices;
- C. The Bordentown Regional School District is not responsible for any alterations, losses or issues with personal devices;
- D. The owner of the device is solely responsible for the physical and technical security of the device;
- E. The guest wireless network internet access is filtered;
- F. The availability of the guest network cannot be guaranteed;
- G. The Bordentown Regional School District cannot guarantee the online security of the guest wireless network;
- H. Users should not transmit credit card information, passwords, or any other sensitive personal information over the district guest wireless network. The district is not responsible for any compromised personal information;
- I. Antivirus, operating system, and software updates are the responsibility of device owner. It is expected that these updates will be performed before the device is brought in district. Downloading of these updates over the district wireless guest network is prohibited;
- J. The Bordentown Regional School District reserves the right in its sole discretion to revoke a user's guest wireless network account or terminate a wireless session at any time;
- K. The Bordentown Regional School District reserves the right to limit bandwidth on the guest wireless network;
- L. The user will not attempt to circumvent or challenge security policies or security measures in place on the network.

Unacceptable Internet Use

Guest wireless network access is a privilege. The following are considered unacceptable uses of the Bordentown Regional School District guest wireless network. Any of these violations will result in revocation

of the user's guest wireless network account. By requesting a guest wireless network account, you agree that you will not:

- A. Attempt to circumvent the web content filtering;
- B. Harass, intimidate, or bully any other individual;
- C. Attempt to view material that is inappropriate in a school setting, including but NOT limited to adult material, gambling, gaming, offensive material, peer 2 peer downloads or any other sites that carry potential risks of security compromise;
- D. Attempt to use social media for personal communication;
- E. Attempt to challenge or gain unauthorized network access;
- F. Give your account information to other users. If found, your account will be disabled and you will be responsible for all activity under your account.

Unacceptable Personal Device Use

The following are considered unacceptable use of personal devices while in district. Any of these violations will result in the user no longer being allowed to use their personal device in district:

- A. Personal devices shall not be connected to the district's wired network via Ethernet cable. Doing so is a violation of network security and will result in the loss of privilege.
- B. The viewing of any files, video, audio, etc. that is not appropriate in a school setting;
- C. The use of any personal or mobile cellular hotspot to gain unfiltered internet access;
- D. Attempt to modify the network in any way. This includes the installation of personal access points, bridges, switches, hubs, routers, or repeaters;
- E. Attempt to challenge any network security measures in place.

Safety

As a safety precaution users are to bring devices in district fully charged. Running a power cable across the floor to plug into a power outlet causes a safety hazard and is prohibited. Battery power must be used while in district.

Devices are not to be left unattended at any time, even for brief periods. The Bordentown Regional School District is not responsible for damage, theft, or loss of any kind to a user's device, software, files, or digital property.
