During the month of March, we are encouraging our students to exercise their minds and "READ FOR THE GOLD"! The purpose of this themed school-wide activity is to continue to promote literacy as a life-long daily habit.

Attached you will find a packet of "Read for the Gold!" Events that includes a checklist of 20 simple reading activities students may complete in order to win a medal prize package at the end of the month. If they complete 15-20 of the events, they can win a gold medal prize package (prizes TBD). For 10-14 events completed, they can win a silver medal prize package (prizes TBD) and anyone completing 5-9 of the events will receive a bronze medal (Prize TBD). The higher the medal, the more prizes you earn! Parents and caregivers should initial when their children complete the events. The "Read for the Gold" packet should be returned to classroom teachers beginning the week of March 26, but no later than March 28.
