

TO OUR VISITORS:

Welcome to the Rutherford County Board of Education. We are glad to have interested citizens at any time.

If you wish to speak to the Board, please make your desire known to the Chairman prior to the beginning of the business session. (See form below.)

Pursuant to Board of Education Policy 5.101, the Board may hear complaints against personnel but only after those complaints have been carried through the proper procedures from the point at which they originate. Policy 5.101 specifies that complaints against teachers be presented to the teacher's immediate supervisor by filling out a complaint form. If the complaint is against a principal, the complaint form shall be submitted to the Director of Schools.

Pursuant to Board of Education Policy 1.404, we ask you to limit the length of your presentation. The time that we will allow to one individual is three (3) minutes. The time limit may be extended to five (5) minutes by the Board Chairman or by a majority vote of the Board. No person will be allowed to make obscene, profane or vulgar remarks, or otherwise engage in actions that breach the peace of a Board meeting.

We appreciate your cooperation in this matter, and your interest in our schools and the work of your School Board. Feel free to visit again soon.

A maximum of thirty (30) minutes at any one school board meeting will be devoted to visitors who wish to speak. Visitors will be recognized to speak in the order their forms are received.

The Board and/or the Director of Schools are not required to respond to visitor comments. The Board and/or the Director of Schools may take visitor comments under advisement if further inquiry is necessary.

IF YOU WISH TO ADDRESS THE BOARD, PLEASE COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING FORM AND PRESENT IT TO THE DIRECTOR OF SCHOOLS' OFFICE AT LEAST FIFTEEN (15) MINUTES PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF THE MEETING.
