## Smart Tuition

If you have had a change of address during the 2016-2017 school year, or if there has been a change in account name, you must notify SMART of the change so you will receive your billing statement each month in the mail for the 2017-2018 school year.

Call SMART Tuition @ 1-888-868-8828 or visit their website.

Also, if you use online Bill Pay for paying tuition through your bank or credit union, you will need to update your account information in June to reflect the 2017-2018 school year, so the check sent by your financial institution will be credited to the appropriate school year (the new school year starts with your July 10th payment).
