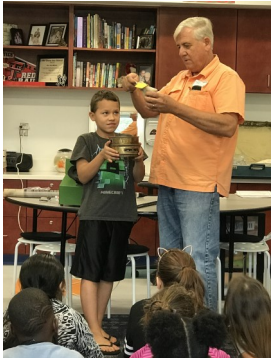

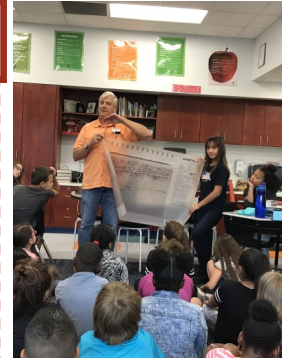

Learning about Earth Science at Lincoln



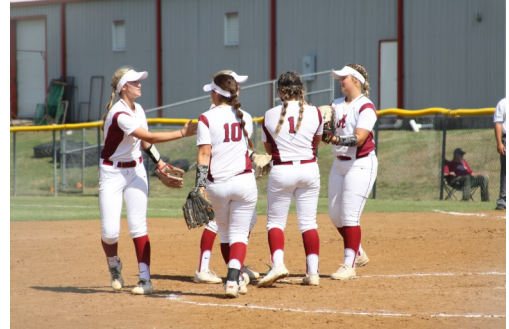
