Grad Nite will be **Saturday, May 12, 2018**. There are only 300 student tickets and there will be 15 adult chaperones over 25. Bus assignments will be made based on the purchase date. Students should report to the outdoor cafeteria by 7am to be grouped by assigned bus. Groups with all students present will board first. The 7 buses will load at 8am sharp in the North Parking lot with an anticipated arrival to Disneyland between 8am and 9am, depending on traffic. All students are required to ride on their assigned bus to and from Disneyland, and will not be allowed to change buses. Students will have full access to both Disneyland and California Adventure Park with other park patrons from 9am to 9pm. At 9pm, seniors with Grad Nite wristbands will then be ushered to California Adventure Park for the private afterhours Grad Nite event until 2am. Students should begin to head towards their assigned bus at 1:30am for a 2am sharp departure. Grad Nite permission slips are for Kennedy Seniors only. Only seniors who are eligible for graduation, debt free, and not on school probation can purchase a Grad Nite ticket. LAUSD is not liable for the personal safety or property of those attending. All Kennedy students must bring a copy of a current student ID. Non-Kennedy students may not participate in Kennedy's Grad Nite. Tickets will not be sold without a valid ID. Tickets are sold on a first come, first served basis. Tickets will be sold in the Parent Center (**Cash only**) as follows:

Friday, March 9: \$180 (plus \$8 for Non-Kennedy PTSA members) - Minimum Day (After School 12:23pm-2pm)

Friday, March 16: \$190 (plus \$8 for Non-Kennedy PTSA members) - Minimum Day (After School 12:23pm-2pm)

Friday, March 23: \$200 (plus \$8 for Non-Kennedy PTSA members) - Regular Day (Lunch)

*Tickets will also be sold during **Parent Conference Night** Thursday, March 8 from 5:30-7:30pm: **\$175** (plus \$8 PTSA membership)

Items Prohibited by Disneyland

- Any outside food or drinks
- Selfie sticks, camera extender, tripods
- Pets (except Service Animals w/Docs)
- Markers, highlighters, laser pointers
- Wagons, skates, Hoverboard electric scooters, skateboards, Heelys shoes
- Bicycles, unicycles, tricycles, scooters motorcycles, remote toys, pogo sticks
- Sling shots, air horns, stink bombs, wireless speakers, silly string, drones
- Suitcases, backpacks or similar bags larger than 15"W x 18"H x 24"D
- Coolers larger than 6-pack (Guests can refrigerate medicine at First Aid)
- Alcohol, marijuana, tobacco, vaping, e-cigarettes, or other illegal substance
- Glass containers or glass perfume bottles (glass prescription bottles ok)
- Costumes, masks, squirt guns, toy guns, blasters, replica weapons
- Sports equipment (bats, helmets, etc)
- Suitcases, backpacks, bags w/ wheels
- Weapons (guns, knives, clubs, brass knuckles, nun chucks, throwing stars, martial arts equipment, etc)
- Self-defense equipment (pepper spray, mace, stun guns, etc)
- Restrain devices (handcuffs, zip ties)
- Suspicious items (box cutters, razor blades, duct tape, wire, etc)
