**Minutes of the January 15<sup>th</sup> Meeting:**

- I. Mr. Spindler welcomed the group and we began our meeting.

- III. Mr. Spindler shared information about an upcoming Community Council conference that is scheduled to take place on Thursday, January 24<sup>th</sup> at Crescent View Middle School in Sandy, Utah. The conference focus is for community council members, state-wide, to network and share best practices with each other. Breakout sessions will have topics such as: Creating Effective Plans, Parent Engagement, Roles of Council Members, Council Compliance Issues, Understanding and Assessing Data, Effective Council Practices, and Sharing Ideas with Key Legislators. Mr. Spindler offered to cover the cost of any members wishing to attend the conference.
- IV. Mr. Spindler provided a copy of the recent USOE Annual Report and Financial Report as it related to the Trustland programming in our state.
- V. Mr. Spindler distributed copies of the Needs Assessment Survey that teachers completed after returning from the Winter Recess. The two most often occurring requests as noted by the Council were related to continuing the Encore Program and the AmeriCorp Program.
- VI. The Council engaged in a discussion around school safety procedures and practices that are in place at the school. Those in attendance shared that they felt that the overall safety of students and staff is pretty effective. Mr. Spindler suggested that we enhance our practice by closing the two sets of wooden doors that offer access to the main hallway. Also, Mr. Spindler said he would remind parents of the sign-in/sign out procedures when visiting the school. The Council was supportive of these measures being enacted. The Council will continue to review and make recommendations for improvements as we move forward in our efforts to keep students and staff as safe as is reasonably possible.
