

# TSD Tutors



The Troy School District is pleased to announce a NEW Pilot, After-School Tutoring Program, for elementary through middle school students. To provide the highest quality tutoring experience, all tutors belong to the outstanding, Troy School District educational community. The pilot program will be located at the following schools:

Barnard, Hamilton, Morse and Wass Elementary Schools & Smith Middle School

Tutoring sessions will begin immediately after school and will run in (4) 55-minute time blocks.

Example: sessions at Barnard (late-start elementary schools):

Session 1=4:10 until 5:05 \* Session 2=5:10 until 6:05 \* Session 3=6:10 until 7:05 \* Session 4=7:10 until 8:05.

There will be 2 tutors at each building. There is a 1 to 3, tutor/student ratio. The cost is \$30 for the 55- minute time block (\$120 for the complete 4-week sequence). Sessions are based on a 4-week sequence of time, in addition, there will be a 2- week sequence, in December. Multiple days, hours, or multiple week sequences may be selected. Sessions occur on the same day of the week at the same time. At the time of registration, a subject: Math, Reading or Homework Help will be selected. Tutoring will begin the week of September 11th.

When registering, the following selections will be made:

1. School (School where tutoring is located)
2. Day of the Week
3. Session Time
4. Dates in 4 week blocks
5. Subject (choice of Math, Reading, Homework Help)

Sample registration:

Barnard \* Mondays \* 4:10 \* September 11th through October 2<sup>nd</sup> \* Math

In this example, tutoring would take place on the following dates: 9/11, 9/18, 9/25 & 10/2 at 4:10 pm at Barnard Elementary school.

At the time of registration, additional information will be requested: grade the student is in, and the school the student attends. A student does not have to attend the school where tutoring is located. For example, a student from Hill could attend tutoring at any of the other elementary schools where tutoring is offered, or a student from Baker could attend tutoring at Smith. Registrations will be accepted on a first-come-first-serve basis; early registration is recommended.

The District will be assessing the Pilot Program in December, and making a decision based on the success of the program, to continue to roll-out the Tutoring Program to other schools in the district.
