Tema: **Aviso referente demostraciones de estudiantes el 14 de marzo, 2018**

Para Todos Estudiantes y Familias de LEUSD:

Buenas tardes. La tragedia reciente en la escuela preparatoria Marjory Stoneman Douglas en Parkland, Florida ha iniciado un movimiento estudiantil imprescindible a través de América.

El miércoles, 14 de marzo, a las 10:00 a.m., bajo las auspicias del movimiento EMPOWER de la marcha de mujeres juveniles, ocurrirán demostraciones a nivel nacional para conmemorar a los 17 estudiantes y maestros víctimas de Parkland, mientras demostrando solidaridad contra violencia. Esto será una observación respetuosa de 17 minutos.

Líderes estudiantiles en nuestras escuelas preparatorias han expresado un deseo de organizar sus propias observaciones escolares el día 14, lo cual, por derecho, se pueden llevar a cabo en el recinto escolar durante las horas escolares.

En el interés de seguridad, reuniones estudiantiles se pueden permitir dentro de las instalaciones escolares, no fuera. Estamos preparados para permitir de forma segura cualquier observación guiada por estudiantes que pueda ocurrir en escuelas preparatorias y secundarias el día 14.

Para escuelas primarias, se pueden coleccionar firmas de rótulos opcionales y apropiados de edad para apoyar a familias de estudiantes en la escuela preparatoria Stoneman Douglas y se pueden enviar a Parkland, Florida.

El 14 de marzo, las escuelas preparatorias y secundarias pueden adaptar los horarios de campanas para permitir las observaciones guiadas por estudiantes en áreas designadas para reunirse en el recinto escolar. Los estudiantes de la escuela preparatoria no serán exentos de restricciones escolares de salir temprano de la escuela.

Subject: **Advisory Regarding Student Demonstrations on March 14, 2018**

To All LEUSD Students and Families:

The recent tragedy at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School in Parkland, Florida has sparked an unprecedented student movement across America.

On Wednesday, March 14, at 10:00 a.m., under the auspices of the Women's March Youth EMPOWER movement, demonstrations nationwide will occur to memorialize the 17 Parkland student and teacher victims, while showing solidarity against violence. This is to be a respectful, 17-minute observance.

Student leaders at our high schools have expressed a desire to organize their own school observances on the 14th, which, by right, may be held on campus during school hours.

In the interest of safety, student gatherings may be allowed on school grounds, not off campus.

We are prepared to safely accommodate any student-led observances that may occur on High School and Middle School campuses on the 14th.

For elementary schools, optional and age-appropriate poster-signings to support families of students at Stoneman Douglas High School may be collected and sent to Parkland, Florida.

On March 14th, Middle and High Schools may adjust bell schedules to accommodate student-led observances in designated assembly areas on campus. High School students will not be exempt from school restrictions on leaving campus early.

Please contact your school principal if you have any questions or concerns regarding voluntary student participation in this observance.
