Texas law now requires that each district evaluate itself and each of its campuses in eight specific categories. San Saba ISD values feedback from its community, staff and students. We appreciate you taking the time to submit an evaluation of various programs within our district as they relate to community and student engagement.

To begin the evaluation, you must access the survey at the following address through the internet: <https://www.thecasesolved.com/get-started> and follow these steps:

1. Click on the blue sign up button in the EVALUATOR block
2. Enter your email address
3. Choose a password
4. Enter: 206901 as San Saba ISD's County District Number
5. Click "create account" in the bottom left corner
6. Select the campus or campuses names you are evaluating and click "save campus" in the bottom left corner. This takes you directly to your campuses welcome message and evaluation page. If you are a community member or parent, please select multiple campuses if you have a child on multiple campuses.
7. Click on "Continue to Evaluation" at the bottom of the welcome message.
8. Slide the evaluation tool from "NA" to "10" to indicate your belief in the success of each program with "10" being "Exemplary" or "NA" meaning "Have no Knowledge or "Not Applicable". You may also enter general comments related to the area that your are evaluating. This option is completely voluntary, and it is not necessary for the district to be in compliance, but we would like to know your comments.
9. The evaluation should take approximately 15 minutes to complete.
10. When completed with all of the questions the program will give you a screen that says: "Evaluation Complete".
11. Click on "My Account" tab at the top of the page and then click "Log Out".
12. You have completed the process.

If you need assistance, please contact your campus office. The results of this survey will be submitted to the Texas Education Agency in June, 2016 and will become a permanent accountability piece for San Saba ISD and each of the campuses.
