Electronic Device Policy

2017-2018

Students are permitted to have in their possession electronic signaling devices while on campus during the instructional day, while attending school sponsored activities and at school related functions provided that it does not disrupt the instructional process.

Electronic signaling devices and accessories for such devices shall be deactivated and not used during the instructional day.

Electronic signaling devices may be carried by students and to school events under the following conditions:

1. Parent completes permission form and acknowledgement of conditions
2. Electronic signaling device is registered with the District
3. Device is not used for unlawful purposes or to gain an educational advantage (cheating).

In permitting the possession of such devices, the Alhambra Unified School District and Alhambra High School assumes no responsibility for the loss of the device. The parents and students assume full responsibility for electronic signaling device if lost or stolen.

Any student who violates these rules is subject to having their device confiscated by any school administrator, teacher, or staff member.

Confiscated devices can be picked up in the Student/Employee Welfare Office before or after school by the student, on the first offense, and by the student's parent or legal guardian on any subsequent offense. After first offense the student and parent are required to sign an Electronic Device Contract. Students violating this rule may also be given a consequence ranging from but not limited to: detention(s), or Behavior Contract.

Attention Staff-please turn-in electronic devices to the Student/Employee Welfare Office by 3pm on the day of confiscation. Do not send a student.

You are responsible for the item until it arrives in our office. Campus supervisors will not be leaving their assigned areas to pick up any devices.
