

TERMS OF ASSIGNMENT

1. The school will direct all communications concerning the pupil to the designated representative, including but not limited to grade reports and notices regarding the pupil's attendance, citizenship, and medical status.
2. The designated representative assumes full responsibility for communicating all such information to the natural parent without delay.
3. The designated representative has the right to examine all records that pertain to the pupil's educational program.
4. The designated representative has the right to make all decisions concerning the pupil's education, health and welfare.
5. The student must actually reside with the designated representative twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week.
6. This agreement does not necessarily grant athletic eligibility.
7. This agreement will be in effect for the balance of the school year in which it is executed if all of the above conditions remain true and correct.
8. In the event that any of the terms stated above are not met, the principal of the school of attendance shall notify the Coordinator, Attendance and Welfare that the Assignment has been rescinded as of the date specified by the principal. The coordinator shall then notify the natural parent, in writing, that the student must return to his/her school of residence. A copy of this letter will be sent to the principal of the school of residence or to the district of residence.
9. This Assignment may be revoked at any time upon the parent's/legal guardian's written request.
