USE OF FACILITIES FOR ELECTIONS

The Board recognizes and fully embraces the concept of citizen participation in the democratic process through the casting of ballots. The Board may give approval for the use of school physical facilities to be used for polling places during elections for public office and for public referendums.

The Board will cooperate fully with the Voter Registration Board.

PARENT-TEACHER RELATED ORGANIZATION

The Board recognizes the valuable services performed by the parent-teacher type organization in the School System such as PTA, PTO, etc. The Board supports school-parent oriented organizations espousing objectives similar to those that follows:

- A. To promote the welfare of children and youth.
- B. To raise the standards of home life.
- C. To secure the adequate laws for the care and protection of children and youth.
- D. To bring into closer relation, the home and the school, that parents and teachers may cooperate intelligently in the educational training of the child.
- E. To develop between educators and the general public such united efforts as will secure for every child the highest advantages in physical, mental, and social education.

The Board further suggests that such recognized parent-school organizations and groups maintain a close liaison with the Board, administration, and staff and the recognition of established School System policies.

Facility Use

The Board considers such organizations as auxiliaries to the schools and not as "outside" groups. Whenever a local parent-school organization is formed and recognized by the school and the Board, it shall be permitted to hold its regular meetings in School System facilities, and it shall be the duty of the principal and the teachers of the school to further the work of the organization. Meetings of such recognized organizations may be held in the buildings with the permission of the school principal without the necessity of agreement required of "outside" groups.

BOOSTER CLUBS

It shall be the policy of the Board to work with and to encourage the support of booster clubs that are organized to promote the best interest of students and schools of Bibb County. Any person(s) wishing to organize a booster club to support and have an official affiliation with any student group, team, etc. or to use a school's or the School System's name in any way must be approved by the Board prior to any such official affiliation and/or involvement with such school or student groups.

Further, any booster club officially affiliated with any school in the School System must abide by the following stipulations:

1. Booster club activities shall be authorized by and coordinated with the school principal or designee.
2. Booster clubs shall not directly or indirectly supplement the pay of band directors, coaches, or any other school employee.
3. All decisions concerning personnel employed by the Board shall be strictly reserved as a Board matter and shall not be the prerogative of any booster club.
