The choice of 7th grade Math class determines a student's path throughout high school

Math courses. Some things to consider in deciding whether to take Pre-AP or regular Math:

- 7th Grade Pre-AP Math moves extremely fast in order to cover one and a half curriculum years
- 7th Grade Pre-AP Math will have much higher expectations and regularly requires homework to be completed outside of class.
- Students should have a strong background in basic Math skills and problem solving to be successful in 7th Grade Pre-AP Math.
(Consistent Level 3 scores on STAAR state tests)
- If a student chooses "regular" 6th Grade Math, they will not be advised to enroll in 7th Grade Pre-AP Math in 7th Grade.
- If a student chooses "regular" 7th Grade Math, they will not be able to enroll in Algebra in 8th Grade.
