2018-2019 Student Registration

You should have received a registration packet for your child. If you have not received a registration packet, please contact the Main Office. Parents/guardians will register their child(ren) for the 2018-2019 school year using **our on-line registration system (Infinite Campus), online acknowledgement forms, and completing/returning several school forms.** All parents/guardians are required to complete the residency form and provide the necessary documentation to be considered enrolled for the 2018-2019 school year.

For 2018-2019 School Year, the registration fee per student is \$100. However, parents/guardians completing the registration process **including completing the residency form and providing the necessary documents** before Friday, June 29, will be eligible for an early registration fee of \$50. Parents/Guardians qualifying for reduce and free student registration fees during this school year will need to complete a School Fee Waiver Form for the 2018-2019 School Year.

In the packet you will find directions for the online registration process, as well as additional paperwork that must be completed. You are welcome to come in to the Main Office between 9:00 – 3:30 to turn in your residency form including the required documentation. If you do not have internet access, you are welcome to come to the Hillside School Main Office between 9:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. to utilize our computers.

On the following days, we will be offering after-school times for parents/guardians to turn in their residency paperwork or access computers to complete the online registration.
