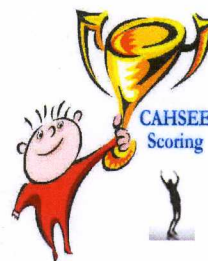
CAHSEE california high school exit exam stepping into your future
