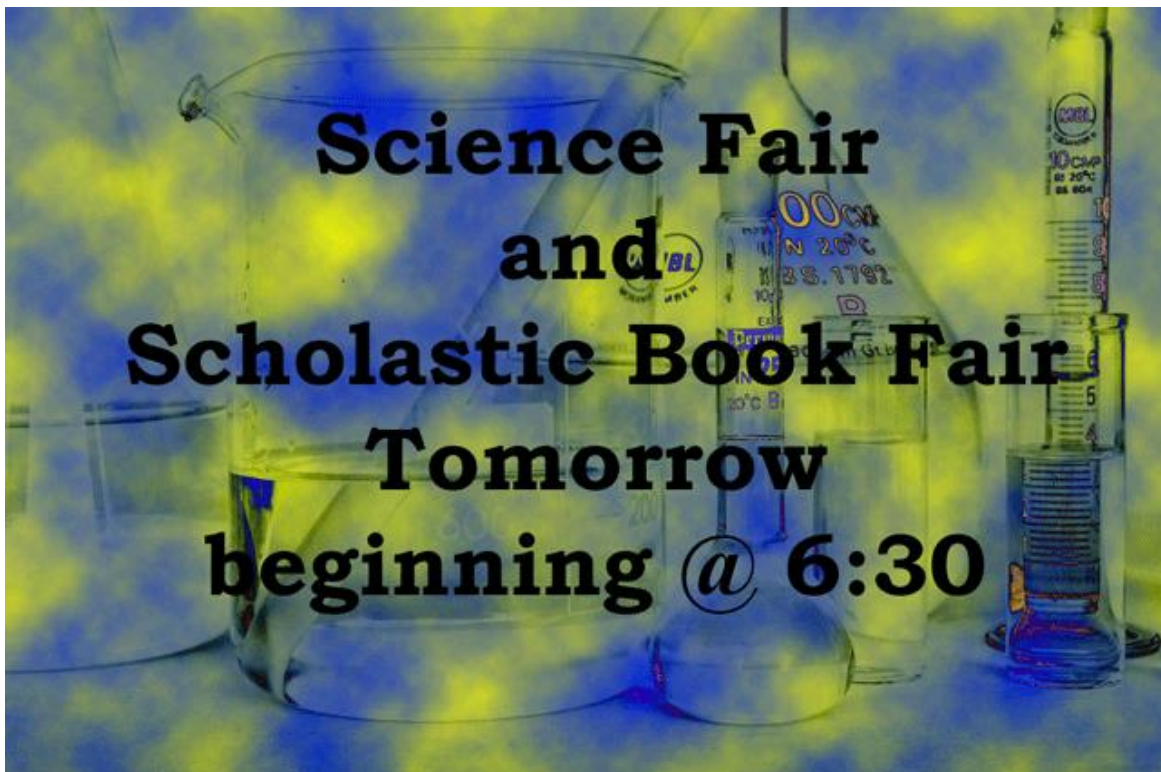

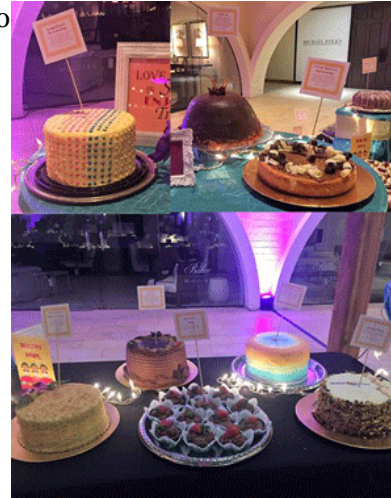

Please remember: The leggings must be navy blue or white and must go down to student's ankles.

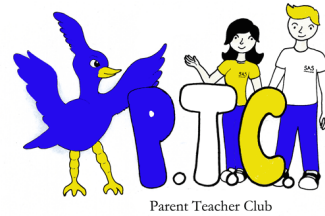

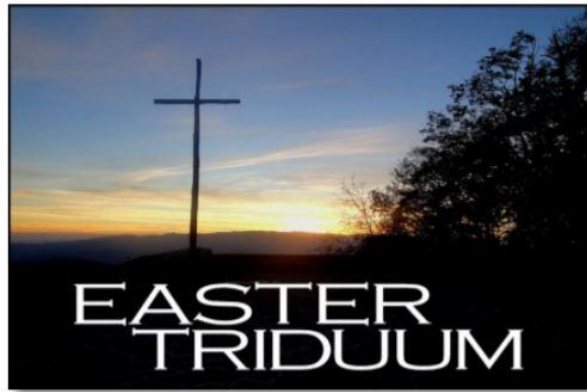

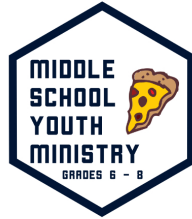
