The fundamental goals of Bayside Community Day School are to provide the students with an opportunity to maintain a positive connection to the academic process, improve their attendance, make-up academic credits, increase basic academic skills and to prepare them for college or the work force. Students are given the opportunity to prepare themselves for graduation or transfer to an alternative program to complete their high school requirements.

Bayside Community Day School is a full six-hour instructional day alternative education program. Small class sizes of 22 students per teacher and instructional assistant provides the greatest level of success for students. The curriculum and course of studies for students enrolled in Bayside is committed to articulate with the established curriculum of the high schools in the district. The alternative approach within the delivery of this curriculum is the unique manner by which students may achieve individual success.
