

Lutheran South Unity School Extended Care Program

Lutheran South Unity School's **Extended Care Program** provides a safe, welcoming environment for the students of LSUS to pray, learn, play, and foster relationships outside of the comprehensive classroom. In turn, parents will be assured in knowing that their child is in a safe and caring environment as they complete their work and ministry before collecting their child.

LSUS operates an **Extended Care Program** for LSUS students K-8. This program gives students a designated, safe place to be before and after regular school hours.

Days of Operation: M-F, when school is in session or as otherwise indicated in school publications

Hours of Operation: 6:30-7:45 AM and 3:10-6 PM

Dates of Operation: When K-8 classes are in session

Hourly and incremental rates are as follows:

Hour: \$3.00 **Half-hour:** \$1.50 **Incremental:** \$0.05 per minute

Should a student not be collected after school, that student will be taken to the ECP Room to await family arrival. This is a safety measure to avoid having unsupervised students.

Billing is done through TADS on a monthly basis.
