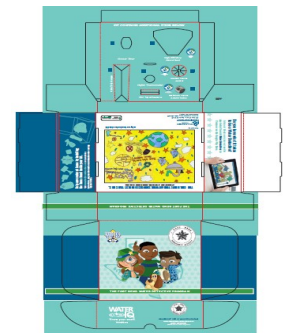


STAFFORD FIRE DEPARTMENT TEACHING FIRE SAFETY

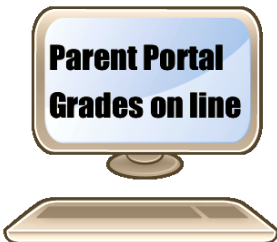
