### **COURSE INFORMATION AND ATTENDANCE POLICY:**

**COURSE INFORMATION:** Most academic courses will be offered in traditional seat-based classes. Students will have the opportunity to earn 5 credits each 2-week session, for a total of 10 credits. Electives and other specialized classes will be offered in an online format through e2020, a web-based learning resource where course credits are earned while learning independently in an online classroom. Students taking online courses will be required to come to East Campus and meet with an instructor Monday - Thursday. Computer labs at CHS East will be open and available for students to use.

\*\*e2020 and online course programs are not accepted by NCAA. If your student is an athlete who wants to attend a NCAA University, they must take a class in which they attend daily.

**ATTENDANCE POLICY:** The highly concentrated courses offered in the high school summer school sessions make full-time attendance necessary. Only 2 absences per session will be allowed. Upon the 3<sup>rd</sup> absence, the student will be automatically dropped.
