5. A person wishing to be heard by the Board of Education shall first be recognized by the President and shall then proceed to comment as briefly as the subject permits.

Agenda Items

Individual speakers shall be allowed to speak for three minutes on any agenda item. The Board of Education shall limit the total time for public input on each agenda item to 21 minutes.

Non-Agenda Items

Individual speakers shall be allowed to speak for a total of three minutes on non-agenda items regardless of the number of issues to be addressed by the individual. The Board of Education shall limit the total time for public input on non-agenda items to 21 minutes.

With Board of Education consent, the president may increase or decrease the time allowed for public presentation, depending on the topic and the number of persons wishing to be heard. The President may take a poll of speakers for or against a particular issue and may ask that additional persons speak only if they have something new to add.
