Purpose of the meeting:

The Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) Committee as defined by Education code (EC) 52060, (EC) 52063, (PVPUSD) AR 0460, and (PVPUSD) BP 0460; are assembled to provide input to the District's LCAP.

The required groups with which the governing board must consult are:

- Teachers
- Principals
- Administrators
- Other school personnel
- Local bargaining units of the school district
- Parents
- Pupils

Two LCAP advisory committees are required by law. They provide advice to the Board and the Superintendent regarding the LCAP requirements and the Annual Update.

- Parent Advisory Committee (PAC) – All districts are required to establish a Parent Advisory Committee which shall be composed of a majority of parents and must include parents of pupils in the unduplicated pupil groups (low income, foster youth and English Learners)
- English Learner Parent Advisory Committee (ELPAC) districts with an enrollment of at least 15% and/or at least 50 English Learners must also establish an English Learner Parent Advisory Committee which shall be composed of a majority of parents of English Learners. For the Palos Verdes Peninsula Unified School District (PVPUSD) this is the District English Learner Advisory Committee (DELAC).
