

# Student Behavior Guidelines

Research has shown that the three factors most crucial to success in school and later in the workplace are regular attendance, punctuality, and excellent social skills. Lahainaluna High School is committed to helping students develop these skills along with other knowledge they will need to be successful beyond high school. Behavior that is expected at Lahainaluna High School includes, but is not limited to the list below. Failure to abide by these guidelines will result in disciplinary actions ranging from reprimand/warning, parent conference, detention, In School Suspension, Out of School Suspension, or dismissal. Violators of these rules will be disciplined on a case-by-case basis depending on the seriousness of the infraction, prior record of violations, and other factors.

- Students must carry their official LHS student photo Identification card at all times.  
Students must report to every class, of each school day, on time
- Students must remain in class until dismissed by the teacher, but in no case should dismissal occur prior to the bell
- Students shall bring required materials to each class. (Textbooks, notebooks, paper, pens/ pencils, planners etc.)
- Students should NOT wear sunglasses and hats inside classrooms
- All withholds (fees for lost, destroyed, or damaged school books or other school issued property) must be paid prior to participation in co-curricular activities (proms, banquets, commencement, etc.)
- Students shall not litter or spit on campus, nor deface (graffiti) any school property (walls , buildings, textbooks, desks, etc.)
- Students must not engage in rumor spreading, gossip, name-calling, arguments, cyber-bullying, or swearing/use of curse words
- Students shall serve cafeteria monitor duty when assigned
- Students shall exhibit proper manners in the cafeteria, and avoid cutting or letting other students cut in the lunch line
- Students will purchase bus passes in a timely fashion (only during morning recess and lunch recess) and obey all bus riders' rules. Students who break bus rules may be suspended from riding the bus
- Students shall familiarize themselves with the "out of bounds" areas of campus
- Students shall not loiter outside classrooms, in stairwells, or in restrooms
- Students shall not bring to school contraband items that may cause bodily harm, property damage, or school disruption, such as: skateboard, shoes with wheels, toys, radios, stereos (including iPod speaker sets), gang related clothing i.e. bandanas and /or insignias , lighters/matches, dice, pepper spray, water balloons, water guns, shaving cream, slippers with storage compartments, or any items restricted by Chapter 19, such as weapons, drugs, cigarettes, or alcoholic beverages, **including vaporless cigarettes/ e-cigarettes or similar**
- Students shall behave in accordance with school rules on campus and while participating in any school event, such as dances, athletic events, field trips, and assemblies
- Students shall not participate in physical, verbal or cyber forms of bullying
