Chromebook Summer Care

Owasso Public Schools is dedicated to your student and enabling them to become lifelong learners. Through our 1:1 initiative each student in has been given a Chromebook for the 2016-17 school year to enhance their learning. The intent and expectation for use of the device is for academic purposes. Students in grades 9-11 will keep their devices this summer, as we encourage them to continually learn. Parents are encouraged to talk with their student about digital citizenship and online safety, as well as ensure their child's compliance with the district's expectations. To ensure the life of the devices please adhere to the following care tips:

- Have a common place that you store your Chromebook so that it does not get misplaced.
- Do **NOT** leave your Chromebook on the charger for more than 12 hours.
- Do **NOT** allow your Chromebook to be stored for any period of time fully discharged.
- Do **NOT** leave your Chromebook in a car or other area in which direct sunlight and heat will damage the device.

If a device is in need of repair you may bring the device to the Mid High on **Mondays between the hours of 1pm and 3pm**. You will give the device to the technician and inform them of the issues. You may return the following week, on Monday between 1pm and 3pm to retrieve your repaired device. If for any reason it is going to take longer than one week to repair, you will be contacted and notified of when you may pickup your device. The office for repairs will be open beginning June 5, 2017.

When you return in August you will need to purchase insurance for your device for the 2017-18 school year. Information regarding the dates and procedures for purchasing the insurance will be posted on the school website as well as sent in a School Way message later this summer.
