FAQs

What is GPA?

GPA is your “grade point average.” You get 4 points for every A, 3 points for every B, 2 points for Cs, and 1 point for Ds. Then that number is divided by how many classes you took to get your GPA.

What are citizenship marks?

Citizenship marks are based on your behavior. This may include participation, helpfulness, being on time and prepared, demonstrating a positive attitude toward learning, etc. Teachers assign an “O” for Outstanding, an “S” for Satisfactory, an “N” if a student Needs Improvement, or a “U” for Unsatisfactory.

Do all of my grades and marks on every progress report count?

No. Only SEMESTER grades and citizenship marks count.

Do P.E. and elective classes count, or just academics?

ALL classes are included in the total GPA.

How will NJHS students be honored?

All eligible students are honored at a ceremony in May. Families are invited to the evening ceremony. Students receive a certificate. If you continue to qualify in high school, you will be eligible for scholarship opportunities.
