



St. Louise Parish School Is Hiring

Three open teaching positions have been newly announced at St. Louise School. We are hiring for one full-time grade 5 teacher, one part-time grade Pre-K teacher, and one part-time Pre-Kindergarten Instructional Assistant all to begin this coming fall.

GRADE 5 TEACHER

The goal of the St. Louise Parish School 5th grade teacher is to create a supportive, caring classroom environment and to team with the other homeroom teacher to produce a quality 5th grade program in which students can master curriculum content, learn appropriate social and study skills, and develop their faith. This position is full time with a competitive salary and excellent benefits.

PRE-KINDERGARTEN TEACHER

The teacher for this position teaches a self-contained preschool classroom of 4-year-olds, for four mornings a week. The teacher is helped by two instructional assistants. This is a .50 FTE position, teaching the 8:15-11:45 a.m. Monday through Thursday class session.

PART TIME PRE-KINDERGARTEN INSTRUCTIONAL ASSISTANT

This position assists in the Pre-K classroom for four mornings a week. This is a non-benefited position, working a 7:30-12:30 Monday through Thursday shift – 20 hours per week. An instructional assistant is desired who appreciates wondrous, eager 4-year-old learners, is a practicing Catholic who is comfortable assisting the teacher in integrating Catholic values and principles in lessons, and possesses the cooperative and organizational skills that will make working under a teacher's guidance successful.
