

## **PRA Academic Eligibility Requirements**

Prospect Ridge Academy High School is dedicated to the principle of academic excellence. While sports and other activities are a very important part of high school life, the main purpose of this institution is to provide a learning environment that stresses academic excellence. Academic athletic eligibility is determined under the constitution and by-laws set forth by the CHSAA and approved by the PRA Board of Directors.

Policies are as follows:

1. During the period of participation, the student must be taking at least 5 classes, or the equivalent.
2. Eligibility will be checked weekly beginning on Tuesdays. Two failures on any weekly eligibility report will make the student athlete ineligible to compete in any interscholastic activity, scrimmage or game from Tuesday of that same week through Monday of the following week. The student athlete will be expected to attend and participate in practices during that time unless a note has been provided to the coach indicating that the student is with a teacher working on their academic eligibility.
3. It is the responsibility of the coach with the assistance of the administration to notify all student athletes of any failure notices that will affect eligibility. It is the responsibility of the student athlete and their parents to work with the teachers to have passing grades.
4. Any questions dealing with academic eligibility for athletics should be directed to the Athletic Director.
