Dear Parents and Community Members,

The Oregon Department of Education has issued this report card to give a comprehensive view of our school compared to WLWV and schools across Oregon.

During the 2014-15 school year, our average attendance was 96%. This demonstrates a high level of commitment on the part of every TRCS family. This was the first year that the state of Oregon implemented the Smarter Balanced testing. Because schools are rated by individual student growth on standardized tests, schools were not rated this year. Ratings will resume next year. Our students scored well on this year's testing:

- * 85% Met or Exceeded Reading Benchmarks (51% Exceeded)
- * 82% Met or Exceeded Math Benchmarks (49% Exceeded)
- * 92% Met or Exceeded Science Benchmarks (31% Exceeded)

We together, have one of the best schools in the State of Oregon. Congratulations to our students, families and staff for this amazing report card!

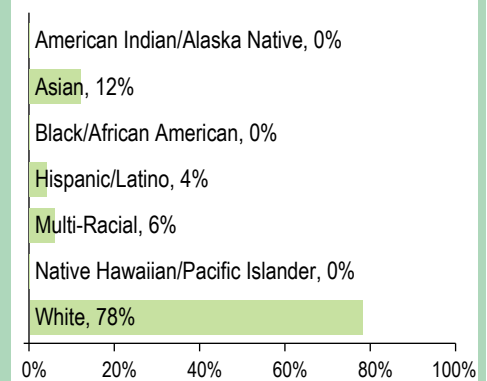

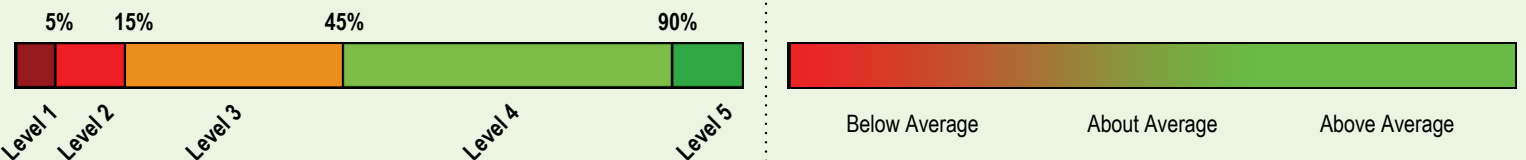
