Scholarship Announcement & Application

PULLMAN EDUCATION FOUNDATION

This scholarship honors the memory of Karin A. Myklebust who passed away in 2007 after a courageous and lengthy battle with cancer. She grew up in Pullman and attended Pullman schools where she excelled in academics and sports. She lettered in basketball and softball two years, was selected to the league all-star softball team, and was a People to People Ambassador to Eastern Europe. She graduated from Pullman High School in 1988. The purpose of this scholarship is to help female athletes from Pullman High School realize their dream of a college degree.

Requirements: 2018 Pullman High School graduate

Award Criteria: The successful applicant must be:

- A graduating female senior at Pullman High School
- Is planning to attend WSU
- A participant in athletics at PHS with preference for fast-pitch softball and basketball.
- Consistently demonstrating: a strong work ethic by always going above and beyond; compassion for others by being there for other people and by being a good listener; leadership potential, but not necessarily by being at the forefront.

Amount of Scholarship: **\$1,000** — Non-recurring scholarship to be used for college expenses during fall semester 2018. The scholarship award will be paid directly to WSU.

Application Process:

- Applicants must submit application form (back of this sheet)
- Submit a letter of application addressing the criteria
- Applicants must have at least two letters of reference submitted which address the criteria (one letter must be from the applicant's coach and one from another adult who knows the applicant well)

APPLICATION DEADLINE: **April 13, 2018.** Turn in hardcopy application with any required materials at the Counseling Center. Incomplete applications or applications received after the deadline will NOT be considered.

Review of applicants is done by the PHS Scholarship Committee (which could include PEF). The Scholarship will be presented at the annual PHS Awards Night to culminate the year. The PULLMAN EDUCATION FOUNDATION reserves the right to alter, amend, withdraw or terminate this scholarship offer at any time and reserves the right not to award this scholarship, all within the sole discretion of the PULLMAN EDUCATION FOUNDATION.
